Under the Curriculum and Credit Framework (CCF)

- With reference to the Govt. Notification. No. 698 Edn(CS)/10M-95/ 14, dated 14/05/2026, **applications are being invited for admission** to Semester Wise Four-Year B.A./ B.Sc. (Honours & Honours with Research) Courses (under Curriculum and Credit Framework) offered by Lady Brabourne College (affiliated to the University of Calcutta).
- Please visit the **Centralised Admission Portal** (<https://wbcap.in/>), an initiative of the West Bengal State Council for Higher Education, Department of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal, to apply to the UG courses offered by Lady Brabourne College. **The Application window will be open from 19-05-2026 to 01-06-2026.**

- Applicants are **required to apply online** within the stipulated time period mentioned in the **Admission Schedule** published by the **Centralised Admission Portal**.
- Candidates should be cautious of information that might be available from dubious sources and beware of fraudulent activities. **The college will NOT be responsible if the applicants fail to follow the communications made through the designated admission portal.**
- Applicants are **NOT** required to physically report to the college campus/college office for submission of documents or for any other reason during the admission process. They should complete the admission process online through the Centralised Admission Portal.
- Candidates will have to **report in person to the college premises** only after online admission for **physical verification of documents as and when notified by the college.**

- **Admission to Lady Brabourne College is strictly merit based.**
- Admission to semester wise 4-year B.A. /B.Sc. (Honours & Honours with Research) Courses under CCF will be guided by the Admission Regulations (Notification No. CSR/05/2023 dated 23.06.2023) of the University of Calcutta and all amendments made thereof.

Duration of the Course: The B.A./ B.Sc. Programme shall be for a duration of Four (04) years Eight (08) semesters (with an exit option after completion of 2nd/4th/6th Semesters).

In-take capacity and Reservation:

The number of seats approved for B.A. /B.Sc. Honours courses offered by the college is given below. Admission will be conducted as per available vacancies in various categories. **Reservation Policy** for admission shall be guided by the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission), Act 2013 and Rules, 2014 and Memorandum No. 330-Edn (CS)/OM-74L/2023, dt., 26.05.2023. For Persons with Disabilities (PwD), reservation will be maintained as per the relevant norms (5% of seats are reserved in each category vide G.O. No. 1084(20)-Edn(U)/EH/1U-89/13 dated 07.12.18 of Dept. of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal).

- SC, ST, OBC-A and OBC-B candidates from states other than West Bengal will not be eligible for reservation benefits and will be treated as General Category candidates.
- SC, ST, OBC -A/B, PWD and EWS candidates should be able to provide valid certificates issued by competent authority during physical verification of documents.
- The minimum eligibility criteria for application to UG courses will be according to the norms set by the University of Calcutta.

Disciplines and Types of Subjects

There are 2 broad Disciplines in the 4-year B.A./B.Sc. Major (Honours and Honours with Research) courses: (i) Humanities & Language, (ii) Science.

i. Major

- The college offers Major in 19 subjects for the semester wise 4-year B.A. /B.SC. (Honours & Honours with Research) courses (under CCF). A candidate will have to choose **any one** of the following 19 subjects as Major:

*There is **NO** provision for admission to **Multi-disciplinary (General) / B. Ed./ B.Com. courses.**

ii. Minor: The college offers the following subjects as Minor:

Minor Subject Combinations:

- The college offers 19 subjects as Minors. The applicants are required to choose *any two* **Minor** subjects offered by the College from the same discipline as the Major.
- It must be noted that in case of Economics and Geography Majors, after successful completion of the course, the degrees conferred may be B.A. or B.Sc. The nomenclature of degree will depend on the Minor Subjects chosen by the candidates. To secure B.Sc. degree in Economics & Geography, a student has to choose both the Minor subjects from Science discipline.

Hostel Accommodation:

- Outstation applicants may apply for accommodation in the hostel of Lady Brabourne College. Hostel Admission will be conducted by the college after completion of the online admission process and physical verification of documents.
- **Hostel seats are limited and admission to the college does not ensure hostel accommodation.** Hostel seat is granted on the basis of merit as well as the distance of the applicant's place of residence from the college campus.
- **Prior notification regarding Hostel Admission will be issued to the admitted students who are eligible for hostel accommodation.**
